- 1 Y/N On a jump ball, does the ball become live when one of the jumpers touches it?
- 2 Y/N On a jump ball does the clock start when the official tosses the ball?
- 3 Y/N Between quarters does the interval of play end when the ball is placed at the disposal of the inbounder?
- 4 Y/N Near the end of the game Team has a throw-in near the opponent's basket. The clock shows 0.2 seconds. A1 catches a pass and then directs the ball into the basket. By rule can the official count the basket?
- 5 Y/N With less than 2:00 minutes to play in the 4th quarter Team A is awarded a throw-in from their backcourt. Team A requests a timeout. Will the throw-in to resume play occur opposite the table at the centre line?
- 6 Y/N After the opposition scores A1 passes the ball in toward A2. The ball deflects off of A2's hand. Should the official wait until Team A gains control of the ball to begin the 8 second count?
- 7 Y/N After the opposition scores A1 passes the ball in toward A2. The ball deflects off of A2's hand. Should the 24 second operator wait until Team A gains control of the ball before starting the 24 second clock?
- 8 Y/N After the opposition scores A1 passes the ball in toward A2. The ball deflects off of B2's hand. Should the official begin the 8 second count when the ball touched B2's hand?
- 9 Y/N After the opposition scores A1 passes the ball in toward A2. The ball deflects off of B2's hand. Should the 24 second operator start the 24 second clock when the ball touches B2's hand?
- 10 Y/N A1 catches the ball with his feet straddling the centre line. A1 lifts the foot in the front court and returns it to the front court. Is this play legal?
- 11 Y/N A1 catches the ball with his feet straddling the centre line. A1 lifts the foot in the back court and returns it to the back court. Is this play legal?
- 12 Y/N A1 catches the ball with his feet straddling the centre line. A1 lifts the foot in the front court and returns it to the back court. Is this play legal?
- 13 Y/N A1 catches the ball with his feet straddling the centre line and passes to A2 who is also straddling the centre line. Is this play legal?

- 26 Y/N While A1 has the ball out of bounds for an alternating possession throw-in, teammate A2 commits a foul. The ball is awarded to Team B for a throw-in. Team B completes the throw-in. Shall the possession arrow now favour Team B?
- 27 Y/N With 1:32 remaining in the 4th period, Team A is scored upon and is granted a substitution. Team B then requests a time-out. Shall the time out be granted to Team B?
- 28 Y/N With 1:32 remaining in the 4th period, the ball goes off B2 out of bounds on the endline in Team A's backcourt. Team B then requests a time-out. Shall the team A throw-in occur from the throw in spot in Team A's frontcourt?
- 29 Y/N With 1:32 remaining in the 4th period, the ball goes off B2 out of bounds on the endline in Team A's backcourt. Team B then requests a timeout. At the end of the Team B timeout Team A requests a timeout. Shall the team A throw-in occur from the throw in spot in Team A's frontcourt?
- 30 Y/N A3 is dribbling the ball from the back court to the front court. A3 has both feet in his front court while dribbling the ball in the back court. In an attempt to change direction, A3 dribbles the ball behind his back. The ball strikes the back of his leg and bounces into the back court. A1 moves into the back court and picks up the ball. Is this a legal play?
- 31 Y/N B3 fouls A3. This is Team B's fifth team foul in the period. The officials erroneously award a throw-in to Team A. After the throw-in, A2 dribbles and scores a basket. Before the ball becomes live again, the officials recognize the error and award A3 two free throws followed by a Team B throw-in. Is this correct?
- 32 Y/N A1 is awarded two free throws. Before the ball is placed at the disposal of A1 for his last free throw, A10 requests to substitute for A3. Shall the substitution be permitted at this time?
- 33 Y/N With 1:45 remaining in quarter 4, A3 is charged with a technical foul. After the free throws, shall Team B be awarded a throw-in from the throw-in spot in their frontcourt?
- 34 Y/N B10 has requested to substitute for free throw shooter B4. B4 violates during the last attempt. May B10 now enter the game for B4?
- 35 Y/N Following a try by A4, the ball is bouncing above the rim when A5 commits a foul. The ball then enters the basket. Shall the goal count?
- 36 Y/N Following a try by A4, the ball is bouncing above the rim when B5 commits a foul. The ball then enters the basket. Shall the goal count?
- 37 Y/N During the last 2 minutes of the game, A4 has dribbled for 6 seconds in Team A's back court when B4 taps the ball out-of-bounds. Team A is granted a time out. The official directs the 24 second clock operator to reset the 24 second clock. Is the official correct?
- 38 Y/N A3 has been in the restricted area for 2 seconds when A1 attempts a field goal. The try falls short of the basket. A3 gains control of the ball and immediately dribbles outside the restricted area. Has A3 committed a 3-second violation?
- 39 Y/N A4 is dribbling the ball near a sideline. A4 loses his balance and steps out of bounds without touching the ball. A4 returns to the court and continues his dribble. Is this legal?
- 40 Y/N Player A1 is assessed a technical foul. Shall this foul count as one of Team A's fouls?

- 41 Y/N Coach A is assessed a technical foul. Shall this foul count as one of Team A's fouls?
- 42 Y/N Team A is granted a timeout but is ready to play after only 20 seconds. Shall the officials resume play immediately?
- 43 Y/N A1 is dribbling in Team A's back court. A1 puts one foot into the front court and while continuing his dribble, changes direction with both feet and the ball now being in Team A's back court. Is this a violation?
- 44 Y/N A4 has been dribbling the ball for 3 seconds in Team A's backcourt when a double foul is committed by A2 and B2. Both players are in Team A's backcourt. When play resumes, shall Team A have the remaining 5 seconds in which to bring the ball into Team A's frontcourt?
- 45 Y/N A4 is been dribbling the ball in Team A's frontcourt when a double foul is committed by A2 and B2. Both players are in Team A's frontcourt. There are 10 seconds remaining on the shot clock. When play resumes, shall the shot clock operator set the shot clock to 14 seconds?
- 46 Y/N A1 is dribbling in Team A's back court. He puts both feet into the front court and stops his dribble. Then, he passes the ball to A2 who is in Team A's back court. Is this legal?
- 47 Y/N A1 jumps from his team's front court, intercepts a pass thrown by B1, and lands in control of the ball with both feet simultaneously straddling the mid-court line. While still straddling the line, A1 dribbles the ball. Is this legal?
- 48 Y/N A1 commits his third technical foul in the game. Must A1 be disqualified?
- 49 Y/N A1 jumps to attempt a try for goal. A1 releases the ball, returns to the floor with one foot and is then fouled by B1. Was the foul committed during the act of shooting?
- 50 Y/N With 1:45 remaining in the 4th quarter. A1 is holding the ball on a throw-in. Before A1 releases the pass B1 fouls A2. By rule shall the official assess an unsportsmanslike foul to B2?
